This award was established to honor Robert Menschel and to perpetuate his commitment to the not-for-profit world by supporting undergraduate internships at nonprofit organizations.

We encourage and invite undergraduate students who have secured an internship with a nonprofit organization for the Fall 2019 semester to apply for this \$1,500 award.

To be considered for the Robert B. Menschel Public Service Award, the applicant:

must be a matriculated student, in good standing, enrolled at Syracuse University;
have an internship at a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, nongovernmental organization;
submit all application materials before the deadline.

Deadline for applications is Monday, September 30, 2019.

Recipients will be notified by email in mid-October and funds will be released directly to student bursar accounts. A short reflection paper about the internship experience will be requested at the end of the semester and provided to the funder.
